At the King County Recovery Coalition (KCRC), our efforts to transform the behavioral health system through policy advocacy and citizen activism are only possible with a strong network of providers like you. We are proud of our progress in **2019/2020**. In the past year, the KCRC:

- Achieved our legislative agenda including increased funding for recovery housing, removing barriers for peer recovery support services, and the New Hope Act helping people who were formerly incarcerated have a fresh start.
- Hosted the first-ever Washington State Recovery Day at the Mariners with nearly 1,800 members of the recovery community.
- Changed public perception of mental health and substance use disorders hosting more than a dozen education and advocacy trainings, and showed up at countless community events to speak out for recovery.
